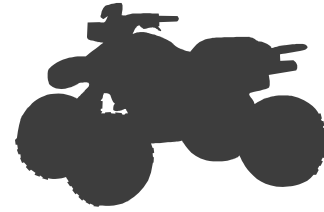


ATVING IN SOUTH TEMISKAMING



To begin your ATV excursion, I recommend a visit to our website www.tritownchamber.ca, for a full list and links to the local events, accommodations and Things To Do in Temiskaming. A printed information package can be mailed directly to your home address.

Here are some of the ATV highlights from enthusiasts in the South Temiskaming Area.

ORGANIZATIONS

- There is no formal ATV organization in area, however there is strong interest and several avid enthusiasts.

ROAD USE

- ATV's, which are licensed & insured, are allowed on most side streets (not the main streets, sidewalks or municipal parks or property) in the City of Temiskaming Shores. Cobalt and Coleman have separate bylaws.
- We encourage folks to contact the local MNR office at 647-6988 about access restrictions or should you require more info.

MAPS

- One of the best maps for local ATVers is the MATIG Map "Fishing, Boating, Snowmobiling & Camping in the North Bay and Temagami areas", with the North Bay area on one side, and Temagami to New Liskeard on the other. It shows lakes, trails, roads, townships, and allowed ATV use within Special Management Areas. www.mitiq.com

FAVOURITE TRAILS

- There are always a few exceptions to any area allowed for ATV's but these are usually well signed. (ie, Back end of Red Squirrel System, small portions of Rabbit Lake Road, etc.-watch the active cut areas in this area as well)
- One of the favourite local spots are the Lorrain / South Lorrain Townships accessible via Hwy 567 at North Cobalt. This will take you to the Montreal River as it flows into Lake Temiskaming, along Hound Chute and Ragged Chute-very historical and the occasional deserted mine. Great ATVing, I can personally recommend. Good spots to camp, swim, pick berries, with breath taking outdoor landscapes. There are a few seasonal camps here that have recently changed ownership, Maiden Bay Camp, Old Mission Resort.
- A second area includes the many roads, trails, and fire access roads along Portage Bay Road. This is just across Hwy. 11, starting at the 11-B entrance to Cobalt in Coleman Twp. ATVs are allowed on township roads in Coleman Twp. Coleman Road (just as you enter the Town of Cobalt on the right) is the road that will take you all the way along the Montreal River. However, I believe there is a way to access this from the end of Bass Lake Road and Gilles Lake.

MORE TRAILS

- Another spot is Beauty Lake Road near Elk Lake. A very good spot to stay is the Long Point Lodge, and ATV the Beauty Lake area. You can spend days there, and never travel the same trail twice.
- In the Temagami area, Rabbit Lake Road is very popular. I have spoken to a few people at that end, but highly recommend you speak directly with Mr. Danny Thomas, at Gramp's Place, he is the local expert. 705-569-3825
- Roosevelt Road is another popular spot, which is along the pipeline. This spot may not be authorized therefore use it at your own risk.
- One last spot is a trail parallel to Twin Lakes Road. You can access by turning off Hwy 65W, west of Temiskaming Shores.
